Substitute language for proposal # 30:

5 AAC 67.022(d) is amended to read:

5 AAC 67.022. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means in the Bristol Bay Area.

(d) In the Naknek River drainage, the following special provisions apply:

...

(4) in the Naknek River from an ADF&G regulatory marker located at Rapids Camp (River Mile 24.25) upstream to an ADF&G regulatory marker located at Trefon's Cabin, (outlet of Naknek Lake),

(A) April 10 through June 7, all sport fishing is closed, except as provided in 5 AAC 67.022(d)(12);

...

(12) a person 16 years of age or older may not sport fish in the Naknek River, during the designated youth fishery day, which occurs on June 7. Bag, possession, and size limits for rainbow trout are provided in 5 AAC 67.022(d)(1)(A), for species other than rainbow trout provisions under 5 AAC 67.020 apply.

(13) a person 16 years of age or older may not sport fish in the Naknek River, from Rapids camp above the ADF&G regulatory marker at 58° 37.42' N. lat., 156° 31.47' W. long. to 58° 37.37' N. lat., 156° 31.22' W. long., during the designated youth fishery day, which occurs on the second Sunday of July;

(14) a person 16 years of age or older may not sport fish in the Naknek River, between the ADF&G markers above and below King Salmon Creek including King Salmon Creek during the designated youth fishery day, which occurs from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on the second Sunday of August;
