

Substitution language to Proposals 130 and 131

I would like to replace the allocation of 600,000 total with 300,000 on the first and second run of Chignik, with a sliding scale of catch effort on the first and second run on the Chignik allocation. From 0 – 30 registered vessels of Chignik; it would be 100,000 on the first and second run with a total of 200,000. From 30 – 60 registered vessels of Chignik. It would be 200,000 on the first and second run, with a total of 400,000. From 60 to the total number of registered permits of Chignik; it would be 300,000 on the first and second runs, with a total of 600,000. The reason for this sliding scale is to reflect in regulation for the SEDM and Northwest Stepovak management plans, a realistic catch effort to a realistic allocation to Chignik of the sockeye salmon passing through SEDM and Northwest Stepovak.
