## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FISHERIES

WHEREAS, the Board of Fisheries recognizes that protecting and preserving our fishery resources, it is necessary to protect and preserve the habitat; and

WHEREAS, this recognition makes it logical and imperative that those charged with preserving and protecting our fisheries and the habitat, work together on common goals and issues; and

WHEREAS, that actions of the Board of Fisheries and actions of the Board of Forestry may have impacts on matters within their individual jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the two Boards have established an informal relationship in an effort to improve communication between the two bodies with the goal of increasing cooperation and avoiding potential conflicts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fisheries is interested in formalizing this relationship to insure that communication and cooperation exists between the two bodies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fisheries is informed that the Board of Forestry is also interested in formalizing its relationship between the two bodies;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Fisheries

RESOLVES as follows:

- 1) The Board of Fisheries requests the Board of Forestry to prepare the more formal protocol as previously discussed between representatives of the Board of Fisheries; and
- 2) That the more formal protocol be presented to both Boards for their review and adoption by the two Boards.
