

5 AAC 92.170. SEALING OF MARTEN, LYNX, BEAVER, OTTER, WOLF, AND WOLVERINE. (a) A person may not possess, transport, or export from the state the untanned skin of a marten taken in Units 1 – 7 and 14 - 16, the untanned skin of a beaver, taken in 1 - 11 and 13 – **15, and 17**, or the untanned skin of a lynx, land otter, wolf, or wolverine, whether taken inside or outside the state, unless the department has sealed the skin. The seal must remain on the skin until the tanning process has commenced or the skin has been transported from the state; however, the seal may be removed from the skin of a marten taken in Units 1 - 5 when the skin has been prepared for shipment from the state; skins must be sealed according to the schedule in (b) of this section.
