Alaska Board of Game Non-resident Hunter Allocation Policy

Pg. 6, No. 5 would be amended to read: (new language is in **Bold**)

5) When a draw hunt is deemed necessary, allocation will be determined on a case by case basis and will be based upon the historical data of nonresident and resident permit, harvest or participation allocation (percentages) over the past ten or more years. When a guided non-resident hunter applies for a drawing permit, proof of having a signed guide-client agreement is required and contracting guides shall be registered in the area prior to the drawing. When a guide signs a guide-client agreement, the guide is providing guiding services and therefore must be registered for the use area at that time.
