ACTUAL TOTAL HARVEST LAST 5 YEARS: (includes general, antlerless, targeted, subsistence)

2018: 240

2017: 198

2014: 177

We have been below, or barely within the low end of harvest objective.

BULL: 100 COW RATIO LAST 5 YEARS

2018: 40 (May be low due to late survey Dec 13-14 2018. Some may have dropped antlers)

2017: 55

2016: 40

2015: 47

2014: 28

These ratios are too high. BoG proposal 126 states a healthy ratio ranges 20-25 Bulls:100cows

EXISTING HUNT STRUCTURE UNIT 15C MOOSE:

General harvest ticket: Spike, 50", or 4 Brow Tine. 185 taken last year

DM 549 antlerless... usually takes 20-30 cows, 29 last year.

AM 550 Targeted (highway corridor) intended for heavy snow years. Hasn't yet been authorized

TM 549 Subsistence (Port Graham area), usually a couple moose taken. 2 last year

Federal subsistence (KNWR lands): 8 taken last year
