Fortymile Caribou Herd update – Jeff Gross

This year's harvest goal will be higher than last year's 2000. Spring data will drive the final number. Likely somewhere between 2000 & 4000. Wolf control suspended in 2018 for 5 year evaluation of predation control program. Contact Jeff gross in Tok for details.

Bob Schmidt: Moose captures to get calf weights to begin 19 FEB. Bison Harvest at 79 – 57 bulls, 22 cows.

Brandy Baker: Burbot telemetry data flights are complete, review forthcoming. Not much data being turned in on ice fishing. Reminder that statewide proposals will be considered at the finfish meeting of the Board Of Fisheries.

b. POGO MINE Meet and Greet: Jeremiah Drewel, Environmental Specialist for Northern Star Resources Limited, (new owners of POGO) visited the AC meeting. He stated that Gbate and road access as well as use rules will remain the same or get more stringent.
