

The Bristol Bay Native Association (BBNA) would like to comment on RC 002 Status Report for Mulchatna Caribou Herd at the January 16, 2020 Work Session. With the current estimated population of approximately 13,500 caribou, which is far below the objective of 30,000-80,000. The BBNA Executive Board is very concerned of the Mulchatna Caribou Herd estimated population and recommend a closure on State land of the winter hunt effective immediately to coincide with the Federal closure.
