









We must adapt...








PSAs Moose vehicle collision, bear messaging, harvest report reminders, wildlife need to know info, to name a few.


We currently have a radio campaign about keeping pets safe on winter trails. It is airing on radio stations around the state a partnership with the Interior Alaska Trappers Association.






