Southcentral Region Meeting Soldotna Sports Center | Soldotna, Alaska March 17 - 22, 2023

Meeting Summary

The Board of Game (board) convened the Southcentral Region meeting on Friday, March 17, 2023 in Soldotna, Alaska at the Soldotna Regional Sports Complex. Seven board members were present: Chairman Jerry Burnett, Vice-Chairman Stosh Hoffman, Allen Barrette, Lynn Keogh, Jake Fletcher, James Cooney, and Ruth Cusack.

The meeting opened with introductions and board member ethics disclosure statements, followed by agency reports. The list of agency reports is provided on page 10. Public testimony began Friday, March 17, 2023 at 1:30 p.m. and concluded Sunday, March 19, at approximately 2:40 p.m. The board heard from 91 testifiers which included 12 advisory committee representatives. (See Record Copy #93 for the complete list).

Board deliberations began Sunday afternoon following the conclusion of public testimony. The board considered 144 proposals, adopting 47 including 16 proposals to reauthorize antlerless moose hunts and brown bear tag fee exemptions for other regions. Board action for each proposal is provided as: C = carried; CA = carried as amended; D = deferred; F = failed; or NA = no action.

The board meeting concluded on Wednesday, March 22, 2023 at approximately 2:30 p.m.
