I find this irreverence by the ADFG to file an "emergency" petition, despite the most recent lawsuit finding this "predator control" unlawful, determinately an insult to the many local Alaskans.

Although not all Alaskans who are against this "predator control" may have submitted a record copy of their dismay, you must know there are many who find this proposal disgusting. I propose adding an easier way for individuals to share their concerns with the ADFG.

Appaling, is that the ADFG is using governmental funds for amoral purposes. Untrustworthy that the ADFG is not sharing these videos of the killings with the public and did not publicly address this event until journalists brought these actions to light. The ADFG must consider the public's opinion and interests of Alaska and must be transparent in all their actions.

I'd also like to see additional research into the hundreds if not thousands of other inputs that might be impacting the mulchatna herd, irrespective of the bears. Removing predators will not resolve this problem.

Please do consider:

- 1. Implementing better documentation and providing video proof and documents for the public's accessibility.
