What is the issue you would like the board to address and why?

Residents of Tanana and Rampart report not meeting their subsistence needs for moose in recent years. They have observed a decline in numbers of moose and are increasingly putting in more effort to try to harvest them.

Currently the ANS for moose is combined for Units 20F and 20C and is 100-130 moose. These two areas are vast and the subsistence use patterns and access are highly varied between these two units.

Did you develop your proposal in coordination with others, or with your local fish and game advisory committee?
